New prescriptions for your Procedure

**Antibiotic-** To reduce the risk of infection, you will be given an antibiotic to be taken during and after the procedure. Your antibiotic may be labeled one of the following:

- Keflex (cephalexin)
- Bactrim (TMP/SMX)
- Cipro (Ciproflaxin)
- Clindamyacin

Remember to take your entire antibiotic until every pill is gone.

**Pain Medication-** a narcotic pain medication will be given before your procedure and to be taken after as needed for pain.

This medication may be labeled:

- Oxycodone or Tramadol (Ultram)

Do not drive while taking this medication.

**Anti-Nausea Medication-** Promethazine (Phenergan) or Ondasetron (Zofran) will be given before and to be taken after your procedure as needed for nausea. It is best to take anti-nausea medication with food 30 to 40 minutes before taking pain meds.
